Pursuant to Woburn Municipal Code Title 3, Article I, Section 3-3(C), and to Rule 31 of the Rules and Orders of the City Council, the President of the City Council has called a Special Meeting of the City Council for Monday, June 9, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, Woburn City Hall, 10 Common Street, Woburn and further, if necessary, the proceedings will continue at a Special Meeting of the City Council on Tuesday, June 10, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, for the purposes of reviewing, conducting a public hearing and taking action as determined by the City Council on the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget, taking action on financial matters presented and pending before the City Council, taking action on financial matters pending in Committee on Finance, providing a first reading for financial matters, and for any other matters that may legally come before the City Council, and, at the time of posting, a listing of topics that the President reasonably anticipates will be discussed are as follows:

 - D. Orders to reauthorize revolving accounts for 1. Mayor (Spence Farm), 2. Conservation Commission (open space), 3. Woburn Police Department (school resources officer), 4. Board of Health (landfill closure), 5. Council on Aging (senior center), 6. Recreation Department (basketball), 7. Department of Public Works (Liberty Elm Tree), 8. Mayor

(special education), 9. Mayor (cable television and telecommunications), 10. Historical Commission (plaques), 11. Board of Health (vaccines) (all pending in Committee on Finance).
